

Buttercup Camps

Ages 3 to 6

Tuesdays & Wednesdays - 9am to 3pm

May 30-31 & June 6-7 & July 18-19

Cost: \$65/wk

This is an outdoor discovery camp for young children and a great introduction to our Forest Preschool program. We will learn songs, do crafts, play games, tend the garden, and explore the woods. Our forest trails and open fields are the perfect setting for our youngest campers to delight in the wonders of nature.

Youth Leadership Training

Ages 13-17

June 22-24 overnight: 6pm Thursday drop off & 11am pick up on Saturday.

Cost: \$60

Hands on leadership and eco-stewardship training that is at the heart of our summer program offerings. Build experience in land skills, handcrafts and working as a team including building trails, gardens & outdoor infrastructure. This is the core training for the summer volunteers and staff and will culminate in hosting the kick-off Summer Pancake breakfast! Meals & tents provided.

Ancestral Skills Overnight Camp,

Ages 8 to 12

July 4-6: Drop off 9am Tuesday; Pick up 4pm Thursday

Cost: \$180

Come together with a community of friends and build your very own base camp at the edge of the woods. Watch the moon rise over the open meadow and sleep under the whispering spruce & fir, in self-made shelters. During the day we will play active woods games, learn to whittle, cook over the campfire and furnish our base camp with basic supplies for surviving two nights in the woods!

Eco-Explorers Camp

Ages 6 to 12

Monday to Thursday, July 10-13: 9am to 4pm

Cost: \$125

Join us for our 16th season of nature camps for kids in Knowlesville! We will explore the woods, follow the streams, visit a natural waterfall and play lots of woody games. Rain or shine we will venture out into the woods to engage our hands, hearts, and minds. Be prepared for wet feet, muddy camouflage and lots of adventure.

Yoga, Plant Magic, Art & Theatre Camp

Ages 6-12

Monday to Thursday, July 24-27: 9am to 4pm

Cost: \$125

This unique camp brings the ancient gifts of yoga, plant medicine, and artistic expression all into one amazing week. Stretch into tree pose and flow into down dog, play balance games, and feel your inner peace. Make poultices, teas, and salves with the helpful plants who live all around us. Bring your sketchbook to the woods and enjoy the rich textures and colours of the Acadian forest. Nourish your body, mind, and soul!

Teen Overnight Camp - Ages 13-17

July 31-Aug 3: Drop off 9am Monday;

Pick up 4pm Thursday

Cost: \$240

Our teens will take off on a grand adventure through the backwoods, trekking across wooded ravines and ridges with minimal gear. Teens will learn to pack lightly and navigate using maps, sun and stars! They will hone fire and bush craft skills building confidence in their ability to survive and thrive in the wilderness. All experience levels are welcome; campers should be ready for physical adventure and sleeping outdoors far from any amenities.

Sol's Fire

Ages 9-12

July 31-Aug 1: 9am to 4pm & Aug 2-3 overnight

Cost: \$180

This camp brings a unique team building experience for boy-identifying campers. Harnessing our capacities to work together and support the growth of inner confidence to help us thrive, rather than just survive, in the wild. Shelter building, carving, fire craft & cooking, team challenge games and more. Build confidence and friendship as we build, craft, play, and laugh.

Luna's Fire @ Fairlight Farm

Ages 9-12

July 31-Aug 1: 9am to 4pm & Aug 2-3 overnight

Cost: \$180

This unique women-led camp is a chance for girl-identifying campers to build confidence and self esteem as we explore survival skills, herbal medicine, journaling, primitive arts and cooking, song, and games. *Note: This camp will take place at Fairlight Farm, just down the road from us.*



Buttercup on the Preserve (Ages 3-5)

Monday Jun 26 9am- 2pm; Cost: \$40

Buttercup campers will learn new songs, do crafts, play games, and explore the beauty of the Meduxnekeag Nature Preserve. An ideal day spent in the woods. Parent accompaniment is welcomed but not necessary.

Eco Explorers on the Preserve (Ages 5-8)

Tuesday June 27 9am-3pm; Cost: \$40

This camp is for those who like to explore their environment. Tree identification, games such as Eagle Eye and nature sit spots will have your Eco Explorer returning home with many findings to report.

Way-finders on the Preserve (Ages 6-10)

Wednesday June 28 9am-4pm; Cost: \$45

This camp is for those who like to adventure off the beaten path. Way-finders will have the an opportunity to develop navigation skills, camouflage and nature craft. Noting watershed topography, landmark trees and building a sun compass, your Way-finder will return home eager to show you their new honed skills.

Plant Magic on the Preserve (Ages 8-12)

Thursday June 29 9am-4pm; Cost: \$45

This camp brings focus to the plants on the preserve. Learning about plant medicine, these magicians in the making will collect plants to make a wild crafted tea and bring home some of their plant magic makings to share with the entire family.
