Cancellation and Refund Policy

Cancellations for any of our camps must be made by telephone or email request. If cancellations are made at least 2 weeks before the camp starts, a cheque will be issued for the full refund of camp fees minus an administration fee of \$25. Cancellations made with less than 2 weeks notice prior to camp start date are entitled to a 50% refund. NOTE: *We cannot provide refunds via e-transfers.*

Sibling discount and Financial Assistance
